At the Beach


We hope everyone has been able to enjoy cooling off for a bit at the beach.

As so many have been enjoying the area, our lost and found bin has been growing daily. The lifeguards place it out at the end of children's activities each day and if you ever want to look thru just stop at the lifeguard room. Please take a look and grab anything that's yours.

As always- the beach is a great place to hang and enjoy the water and great company. We just ask that you pick up after yourselves. Garbage cans are at the boathouse ramp for all to use.

Water update- NJDEP tests and monitors Greenwood lake (NJ side) for HAB- harmful algae bloom. There are many areas of the lake that they sample. Awosting has a designated test site along our shore front.

Our most recent test (this past week) put us in the orange (moderate



health risk) category. We have signs posted at the entry to the beach. The beach is open and staffed. We do not know the testing schedule. We will continue to post the most recent reports as they come in. Please be aware and do what you feel is best for yourself/family.

We have an independent lab that tests our E.coli levels each week under state guidelines. All water tests are logged in our lifeguard book for records. We are currently below the cut off and the water is safe.

Lifeguards-

We want to give a big THANK YOU to our amazing lifeguards for keeping us safe and the beach clean! We truly could not have such an amazing beach without them!! With that being said, many of our lifeguards are leaving for college in the middle/end of August.

The last few weeks of the summer- lifeguard coverage may be spotty. We are doing what we can to ensure the safety of everyone. You will hear from Beach Director, Candice, as issues arise.
